This is just a "readme" that web servers like Apache usually display when they index a directory.

Each directories contains all the documentation in several formats. Here is a description:

`dvi/`

DVI Format, build by TeX.  
Read with the command `xdvi`

`htm/`

HTML format in single page.  
Read with any web browser.

`html/`

HTML format in several pages.  
Read with any web browser.

`info/`

Info format.  
Read with the command `info`

`lyx/`

LyX format. LyX is a WYSIWYM editor (What You See Is What You Mean)  
Read with the `lyx` editor.

`man/`

Man format. Pages de manuel Unix  
Read with the `man` command

`pdf/`

PDF format.  
Read with the `acroread` software (alias Acrobat Reader)

`ps/`

PostScript format.  
Read with the `gv` software (alias GhostView)

`rtf/`

RTF format.  
Read with any text editor.

`sgml/`

Format SGML.  
Read with any text editor.

`tex/`

Format TeX.  
Read with any text editor.

txt/

Format ASCII.

Read with any text editor like vi, nedit, emacs, notepad etc.
